



Radio or Telephone communication between the Marshalling Area and the Recording Room at Coast & Valley Meets.

This guideline is for where radio or telephone communication regarding amalgamations and reseeds between the Marshalls and the Recorders can be used at Coast & valley meets.

Decision

Once

- the event is **closed**
- with all **withdrawals** and
- **no shows** being noted;

The Marshall should decide if a **reseed** or **amalgamation** is possible, the following procedure is to occur.

Marshal

The Marshall then calls the Chief Recorder / Computer Operator, clearly identifying themselves. Marshal to state:

- **Event** - The event number and name of event.
- **Action** - If it is an amalgamation or reseed.
- **Withdrawals** - Clearly state the withdrawals i.e. Swimmers
 - Name,
 - Heat and
 - Lane Number.

Chief Recorder

Chief Recorder to

- **Confirmation** - read back withdrawals and non shows for confirmation.
- **Approval** - Chief recorder to report to referee to approve amalgamation or reseed.
- **Computer** - Chief recorder to complete reseed and amalgamation with computer operator.

Marshal

Marshal will then collect paperwork from recording room and hand swimmers over to the Check Starter.

Marshal requires confirmation of decision of referee
